



### **German Intensive Group Courses 2025**


### 20 lessons x 45 min. per week, daily, Monday to Friday 8.30–11.50 or 13.40 – 17.00

Our courses will teach you high German and our German trainers are trained educators who possess demonstrable experience and skill in the teaching of German as a foreign language. They practice the inlingua method, which means that the course is conducted in the target language and the students do most of the talking. In the afternoon or evening you will have time for your homework and revision.

#### Course Dates 2025

Absolute beginners have to choose one of the dates listed below and start on the official first day of the course. Students, who have some knowledge of German already, are required to take a placement test in order to be placed in a group that best suits their level. Although, it is recommended that these students start their course on the official first day of the course, like the others, a later course start might be arranged.

All intensive courses last 4 weeks and take place Mon-Fri 8:30–11:50 or 13:40 – 17:00 o'clock. Every CEFR Level takes 8 weeks (2 courses) except B2 and C1 which take 12 weeks (3 courses). Intensive courses have 4 to max. 10 participants and are guaranteed to run providing there are 4 or more participants. Intensive courses do not take place on official bank holidays. Makeup appointments are arranged directly together with the other students and the trainer. Book shipping costs will be charged. **Registration deadline Wednesday 5 p.m. before course start.**

#### **FAQs**

How do I register?

You can choose between registering during a cost-free appointment with one of our study consultants, and sending the enclosed registration form via mail or e-mail to us after you have filled it out. Afterwards, you will receive a booking confirmation, our general terms and conditions and an invoice. You must register by Wednesday at 5 p.m. before the starting date any Monday.

What are your payment terms?

Your course must be paid in full at least 14 days before the start of the course. If you are not yet in Switzerland and cannot pay in person, you must pay the fees so that they reach us by 14 days before the start of the course. Our bank details can be found on every invoice. You can only start your course once the fees have been paid in full. Please bring the payment confirmation slip with you on the first day of your course.

Are courses guaranteed to start?

For quality reasons we never allow less than 4 and more than 10 people in one intensive group. We reserve the right to postpone or cancel courses in the event that the minimum number of students is not found before the start date of the course. Courses that do not have the required minimum number of registrations on the Wednesday at 5 p.m. before the planned start date will be postponed by one week; you will be notified by email.

Can I cancel a booked course?

Course cancellations require notification to inlingua Basel in writing (e-mail, letter). For deadlines, the date that inlingua Basel receives notification of withdrawal is relevant. Confirmed language courses can be cancelled or postponed up to 14 days before the start of the course without charge. Later cancellations cannot be accepted and the course fees are payable in full. The fee for course materials is non-refundable once the materials have been handed out.

What if I have to start a new job?

Many participants in the intensive course are looking for work. If you find a job and have to leave the intensive course, you must give us one week's notice in writing (email). Your credit for unused lessons in the intensive course can then be transferred to any other course at your level, on a starting date of your choice, e.g. groups in the evening or private lessons. The amount of your credit will be divided by the lesson price of the new course you choose. If you do not give us one week's notice, you will lose one week's worth of credit, but the rest of your credit can be used for any other course.

Can I catch up on missed classes?

Missed classes cannot be made up for. However, you can find out about homework and what was covered in class that morning either in your personal course folder online or contact reception after 4 p.m.

Can I participate online?

Our teachers teach "hybrid courses": The teacher teaches face-to-face in the classroom using our normal teaching method (focus on speaking). If you wish, you can also take part in the course virtually using a large screen / camera.

Can I get a second book?

If you paid for a paper book, and now you want an ebook (the same book) we will give you the second book at a reduced price. Or if you received an ebook, and now wish to have the paper version, also here you may purchase it at a reduced price.
